Rules and Regulations Reminders

GARBAGE: garbage bins should be stored inside the garage. Bins and any yard bags may be placed at the curb at 6pm the night before scheduled pick up, no earlier.

<u>UNSIGHTLY AND UNKEMPT PROPERTY</u>: Keep your home looking good. Such things to address and correct are peeling paint, weedy driveways, and proper window dressings, among other aesthetic components of your home.

<u>LAWN AND LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE</u>: Lawns must be maintained and free of excessive weeds. Trees and bushes must be trimmed of any dead branches. Entire property must be cleared of trash and debris.
